1st Timothy 2:4 – *God desires all men to be saved, and to come to the knowledge of the truth*

Isaiah 35:8 – *A highway shall be there, a roadway, and it will be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean will not travel on it, but it will be for him who walks that way, and fools will not wander on it.*
