Assuming Jesus is With Us

[ **A** Key Verses **7** ]

**John 15:15** – *No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.*

**Luke 2:41** – *Now His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover.*

**Luke 2:42** – *And when He was twelve years old, they having gone up according to the custom of the Feast of Passover.*

**Luke 2:43** – *After having completed the days, and them returning, the boy Jesus remained behind in Jerusalem. But the parents of Him did not know.*

**Luke 2:44** – *Having supposed now Him to be in their company, they went a day's journey, and then began seeking Him among their relatives and acquaintances.*

**Luke 2:45** – *and not having found Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him.*

**Matthew 18:20** – *Where two or three gathered together unto My name, there I am in the midst of them.*

*Jerusalem – ‘the dwelling of God’s peace’*
- [10] ***hy-pes-TREP-san***  
*they returned – ‘to turn back, or to return’*
- [29] ***MEH-so***  
*midst – ‘in the middle, between or the focus of’*

*supposed – to think, assume, consider or to believe’*
