

[**A** Key Verses **5**]

Exodus 31:13 – *You are to speak to the sons of Israel, saying, ‘Truly My Sabbaths you shall keep, for it is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am Yahweh who sanctifies you.’ ”*

Hebrews 12:2 – *Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

Luke 2:43 – *And as they were returning, after spending the full number of days, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. But His parents were unaware of it.*
