Ephesians 6:10 thru 18 – *The full list of the armor of God*

John 8:19 – *So, they were saying to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me nor My Father; if you knew Me, you would know My Father also."*

Luke 2:48 – *When His parents saw Him, they were astonished. And His mother said to Him, "Son why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for You."*

Luke 2:49 – *"Why were you searching for Me?" He asked. "Didn't you know I had to be about My Father's business?"*

Luke 2:50 – *And they not understood the word that He spoke to them.*

Matthew 12:38 – *Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You."*

Matthew 12:39 – *And answering He said to them, "A generation of evil adulteresses, a sign seeks for, and a sign not will be given to it, if not the sign of Jonah the prophet."*

Matthew 12:40 – *"Just as for Jonah in the belly of the great fish three days and three nights so will be the Son of Man in the heart of the earth three days and three nights."*

adulterous – 'relating to, characterized by or given to adultery'
