

[A Key Verses 6]

2nd Peter 3:9 – *The LORD does not delay His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not willing for any to perish, but for all to repentance come.*

John 14:26 – *However, the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom will send the Father in the name of Me, He will teach you all things and will bring remembrance to you all things that I have said to you.*

Matthew 25:31 – *But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.*

Matthew 25:32 – *All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them one from another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats;*

Matthew 25:33 – *And He will set—indeed the sheep on the right hand of Him—and the goats on the left.*

- [2] **ap-POL-les-the-eye**
perish – ‘to destroy, to lose or to bring ruin’
- [23] **decks-ee-ON**
right – ‘on the right hand or the right side’
- [2] **did-AX-ee-eye**
teach – ‘to teach, to direct and/or to admonish’
- [1] **er-RIH-phon**
goat – ‘a goat, gives the picture of a young goat or kid and figuratively means any person not submissive to Christ’
- [53] **ETH-nee**
nations – ‘the race of people, delineated by ethnicity, common culture, language and/or heritage’
- [1] **kat-ter-RAH-men-oi**
being cursed – ‘to curse, to doom or to invoke evil upon’

patient – ‘long suffering, forbearance and perseverance’
