

Audio Sermon Message #2 Knowledge Before Faith

[A Key Verses 4]

1st Peter 5:8 – *“Be of sober spirit, be on the alert; Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.”*

1st Timothy 2:4 – *“Who wants all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.”*

2nd Peter 1:20 – *But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture becomes a matter of one’s own interpretation*

Matthew 28:20 – *“Teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”*

consummate – ‘compete in every detail, or perfect’

consummation – ‘the ultimate end or the finish’

direct testimony – ‘a witness giving sworn statements regarding what they themselves have directly observed’

firsthand – ‘testimony which is delivered in person’

hearsay – ‘testimony which is the equivalent of a rumor’

rapture – ‘bodily removal of the church up to Heaven’

reprove – ‘the effort made to ensure people remain on track’

rumor – ‘a statement or report made without having known authority for its truth’

age – ‘a stretch of time characterized by containing a specific task’
- [10] **eh-pig-NO-syn**
knowledge – ‘complete recognition, a full discernment of knowledge which is directed towards a particular object’

prophesying – ‘the gift of communicating and enforcing truth’
- [2] **syn-TEL-ee-ahs**
completion – ‘the completion of a joint action or public service and at the consummation of the age, when the activity reaches its intended climax’

observe – ‘to watch over, to guard or to keep intact’
