

## [ A Key Verses 11 ]

**Daniel 9:24** – *“Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place.”*

**Daniel 9:25** – *“So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.”*

**Hebrews 11:1** – *“Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen”*

**Hebrews 11:2** – *“In this the ancients were commended.”*

**Hebrews 11:39** – *“And all these ancient people, having been commended through their faith, yet did not receive what was promised,”*

**Hebrews 12:3** – *“Then fully consider Him, the One who endured such great hostility from sinners against Himself, so that you shall not grow weary in your life here on earth and lose heart.”*

**Nehemiah 8:9** – *“And said Nehemiah, he was governor, to Ezra the chief priest and scribe, to the Levites who taught the people, and to all the people, he said, . ‘that this day is holy to Yahweh your God, do not mourn nor weep.’ For all the people wept .when they heard the words of the law,’ ”*

**Nehemiah 8:10** – *“And said Nehemiah to them, ‘Go your way and eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared, for holy is this day to our God Yahweh, and do not do sorrow for the joy of the LORD Yahweh is your strength.”*
