Preaching to the Humble

[**A** Key Verses **8**]

Isaiah 61:1 – *“The Spirit of the LORD GOD is upon Me, because YAHWEH has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the humble.”*

Luke 4:1 – *Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led around by the Spirit in the wilderness.*

Luke 4:2 – *For forty days, being tempted by the devil. And He ate nothing during those days, and when they had ended, he became hungry.*

Luke 4:14 – *And returned Jesus in the power of the Spirit to Galilee; and a report went out into all the surrounding region concerning Him.*

Luke 4:15 – *And He began teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all.*

Luke 4:16 – *And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read.*

Luke 4:17 – *And there was given to Him the scroll of the prophet Isaiah, and having unrolled the scroll, He found the place where it was written.*

Psalms 34:18 – *“The LORD is near to the brokenhearted—and saves those who are crushed in spirit.*

[**B** Definitions **3**]

consecrated – ‘to be made or declared sacred’

contrite – ‘feeling or showing sorrow and remorse for improper or objectional behavior’

Year of Jubilee – ‘occurred every 50th year to prevent the permanent enslavement of individuals and to ensure economic disparities did not become entrenched’

[2] **FAY-may**

report – ‘news, gossip or a report which is spread among the people’

[16] **hyoo-REN**

he found – ‘to find or discover something after searching for it’

[6] **hy-pes-TREP-sen**

returned – ‘to turn back or to return’

[7] **yoo-an-ghel-LIS-sas-they-eye**

Gospel – ‘to evangelize or preach the good news of the Gospel’

[**D** Hebrew Words **14**]

- [20] **ah-NAH**
afflicted – ‘to be humble or to be afflicted’
- [11] **ah-NAH-whim**
humble – ‘to be humble, meek or lowly’
afflicted – ‘grievously affected or troubled (as by the affliction of sin)’
- [1] **dak-KEH-ee**
crushed – ‘to be crushed or contrite’
- [7] **deh-ROHR**
liberty – ‘freedom, release or forgiveness’
- [99] **hay-YAH**
name of God – ‘to be or to exist’
- [1] **KO-wa-akh**
freedom – ‘the opening of the eyes or to recover one’s sight’
- [1] **la-hah-BOS**
to heal – ‘to bind or to bandage’
- [3] **leh-bah-SER**
to preach good tidings – ‘to bring good news, a positive announcement or cheerful proclamation’
- [2] **leh-nis-BAH-rey**
the brokenhearted – ‘to break, shatter or to destroy’
- [20] **liq-RO**
proclaim – ‘to call out’
- [1] **lish-vue-LIM**
captives – ‘to be taken and confined’
- [2] **mah-SAH**
anointed – ‘to smear, consecrate or to paint’
- [1] **weh-lah-ah-SUE-rim**
prisoners – ‘to bind, to restrain or to tie up.’
- [608] **yah-WEH**
God Almighty – ‘an abbreviation of the proper name of God. Y H V & H’
