Matthew 7:13 – *“Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the highway—leading to destruction and many are those entering through it.”*

Matthew 28:20 – *“Go therefore and assemble eager and enthusiastic disciples, who are who are willing to put in the effort equivalent to earnest college level students, and utilizing immersion learning techniques and principals, teach them all that can be learned about God the Father, Jesus His Son and the Holy Spirit, and instruct them using My word as given to you in the Bible, to obey everything that I have charged you with.”*
