Deuteronomy 6:5 – *“And you shall love Yahweh your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength.”*

John 14:21 – *“The one having the commandments of Me and keeping them, he is the one loving Me; and the one now loving Me, will be loved by the Father of Me; and I will love him and will show Myself to him.”*

Luke 11:46 – *“Also to you scribes, woe to you! For you burden the people with burdens too heavy to bear, and you yourselves will not touch those burdens with even a finger.”*

body – *‘represents the physical things we do or perform’*

conduct – *‘the act of conducting ourselves, as to the direction and management of our behavior’*

consciousness – *‘the state of being conscious, having an awareness of one’s own existence’*

force – *‘the physical power or strength possessed by a human being’*

injunction – *‘a judicial process or order requiring the person or persons to whom it is directed to do a particular act or to refrain from doing a particular act’*

manifest – *‘to prove by putting beyond doubt or question’*

mind – *‘represents what we truly believe and think’*

ordinance – *‘an authoritative rule, a decree or a command’*

path – *‘a course of action, a person’s conduct and a process to be followed’*

soul – *‘represents our consciousness and our destiny’*

love – ‘a sacrificial type of love, characterized by a commitment to others, regardless of personal cost or reciprocation’
- [1] **ah-gah-PEH-so**
will love – ‘a love reserved for just such disciples’
- [1] **ah-gah-PEH-thes-seh-tie**
will be loved – ‘a special love that only God the Father can have towards these exceptional persons who have come to love His Son’
- [86] **EH-khon**
having – ‘to have, to hold in the hand or to possess’
- [1] **em-phan-IS-so**
will show – ‘to make manifest’
