God Alone Sets the Rules

[**A** Key Verses **5**]

Acts 4:12 – *“And there is salvation in no one else; for there is not another name under heaven having been given among men by which it absolutely is necessary for us to be saved.”*

Exodus 20:7 – *“You shall take not the name of Yahweh your God in vain, for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless who takes in vain His name.”*

Isaiah 29:13 – *“Inasmuch as this people draw near with their mouths and with their lips they honor Me But their hearts far have been removed from Me, and their reverence Me consists of commandments taught by men.”*

Isaiah 52:11 – *“Depart, depart, go out from there touch no unclean thing go out from their midst purify yourselves you who bear the articles of Yahweh.”*

Matthew 15:8 – *“THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.*

[**B** Definitions **3**]

idolatry – *‘blasphemous behavior, which is impious utterances or actions concerning God or sacred things’*

Pharisees – *‘members of a Jewish sect that flourished in both the 1st century BC and in the 1st century AD’*

to bear – *‘to be fit for, or to be worthy of’*

[C Hebrew Words 9]

- [1] **hib-bah-RU**
purify yourselves – ‘to clarify or to select’
- [11] **las-SHAV**
in vain – ‘emptiness, falsehood and worthlessness’
- [4] **mit-TOW-kah**
from their midst– ‘to sever or bisect from the middle’
- [99] **pair-rue-SHIM**
Pharisee – ‘to be separate or to be detached’
- [12] **su-RUE**
depart – ‘to turn aside, to remove or to take away’
- [41] **taw-ME**
unclean – ‘to be foul or defiled’
- [4] **tig-ah-YOU**
touch – ‘to lay a hand upon or to fasten oneself to’
- [25] **tis-SAW**
you shall take – ‘to lift, to carry or to bear’
- [5] **yeh-naw-QEH**
will hold him guiltless – ‘to be innocent, to be free or to be exempt’
