

## [ A Key Verses 11 ]

**Exodus 20:12** – *Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.*

**Isaiah 29:13** – *Then the LORD said, "Because this people draw near with their words and honor Me with their lip service, but they remove their hearts far from Me, and their reverence for Me consists of tradition learned by rote.*

**Matthew 15:2** – *"Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hand when they eat bread?"*

**Matthew 15:3** – *And He answered and said to them, "Why do you yourselves transgress the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition?"*

**Matthew 15:4** – *But God said, "HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER, and, "HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER IS TO BE PUT TO DEATH."*

**Matthew 15:5** – *But you say, "Whoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever I have that would help you has instead been given to God."*

**Matthew 15:9** – *BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.*

**Matthew 15:11** – *It is not what enters into the mouth that defiles the man, but what proceeds out of the mouth, this is what defiles the man.*

**Matthew 15:13** – *But He answered and said, "Every plant which My heavenly Father did not plant shall be uprooted."*

**Matthew 15:14** – *Let them alone; they are blind guides of the blind. And if a blind man guides a blind man, both will fall into a pit."*

**Matthew 15:20** – *"These are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile the man."*

## [ B Definitions 3 ]

**despise** – 'to look down on with disrespect or aversion'

**mentor** – 'a trusted counselor or guide'

**vain** – 'marked by futility or ineffectualness'

- [2] **af-phe-DRONE-ah**  
eliminated – ‘of a latrine or sewer’
- [3] **BOTH-ee-non**  
pit – ‘a deep hole, a place of danger, of entrapment or destruction.’
- [1] **ek-riz-ZOO-the-seh-tie**  
uprooted – ‘the action of uprooting or removing something from its foundation’
- [1] **ek-ROW-sah-tay**  
invalidating – ‘to annul, make void or nullify’
- [14] **hy-po-krit-TIE**  
hypocrites – ‘someone who pretends to be something they are not, particularly in moral or religious sense’
- [6] **koi-NOI**  
defiled – ‘to defile or to profane’

- [4] **kaw-BED**  
honor – ‘heavy or burdensome’

gift – ‘a gift dedicated to God’
