Hijacking God's Message

[A Key Verses 11]

2nd Corinthians 6:14 – *Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteous and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?*

2nd Corinthians 6:15 – *Or what harmony has Christ with Belier, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever?*

2nd Corinthians 6:16 – *Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols?*

2nd Corinthians 6:17 – *“THEREFORE, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE,” says the LORD. “AND TOUCH NOTHING UNCLEAN; and I will welcome you.”*

Colossians 3:17 – *Whatever you do in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.*

Deuteronomy 8:10 – *“And when you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless Yahweh your God for the good land which He has given you.*

Luke 11:38 – *And the Pharisee, having seen it, marveled that Jesus had not first washed before the dinner.*

Luke 11:39 – *“Now you Pharisees cleanse the outside of the cup and of the platter, but the inside of you, you are full of plundering and wickedness.”*

Matthew 15:8 – *“THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.”*

Matthew 15:9 – *“In vain they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the precepts of men.”*

Revelation 18:4 – *Come out of her, my people, so that you will not participate in her sins and receive of her plagues.*

[B Definitions 1]

lip service – *‘giving verbal encouragement in support of someone but refusing whatsoever to render any assistance via their own actions or behavior’*

[C Greek Words 17]

[1] **af-for-RIST-the-tay**
be separate – *‘to mark off boundaries’*

[5] **ah-KAH-thar-too**
unclean – *‘demonic impurity’*

[6] **did-ask-al-LIE-as**
doctrines – *‘the content of the instruction as given by Jesus’*

[5] **eh-bap-TIS-they**
he washed – *‘to ritually or ceremonially wash by immersion or dipping’*

- [3] **en-TAL-ma-tah**
precepts – ‘an ordinance, a command or an order’
- [4] **eth-ow-MAH-sen**
marveled – ‘astonishment, to cause to wonder, or to be amazed’
- [2] **ex-EL-tha-tate**
come out – ‘to come out or to depart from’
- [2] **GHEH-mai**
full – ‘to be fully occupied with evil’
- [1] **HAP-tes-they**
touch – ‘to be influenced’
- [2] **har-pag-GES**
plundering – ‘the act of plundering, seizing by force or by robbery’
- [3] **kath-ar-RISE-zeh-tay**
cleanse – ‘to make clean or to purify’
- [2] **mah-TAYN**
in vain – ‘having no purpose or making futile efforts’
- [1] **PIN-ak-os**
platter – ‘a flat surface used for serving food, or a tablet used for writing’
- [5] **play-GON**
plagues – ‘a blow to the body or a resulting wound’
- [3] **pon-ner-REE-as**
wickedness – ‘evil, malice or iniquity’
- [4] **po-TER-ree-oo**
cup – ‘a vessel for drinking’
- [2] **SEH-bon-tie**
they worship – ‘to show great reverence in the act of worshipping God’

[**D** Hebrew Words **3**]

- [1] **oh-beh-RAK-tah**
then you shall bless – ‘to kneel, to bless God or to speak well of Him’
- [15] **weh-ah-KAL-ta**
and when you have eaten – ‘to eat or to consume’
- [4] **weh-sah-BAH-eh-tah**
and are full – ‘to be satisfied, or to have in excess’
