Genesis 4:1 – *And Adam knew Eve his wife and she conceived, and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from Yahweh.*

Genesis 4:2 – *And she again bore this time, his brother, Abel. And was Abel a keeper of flocks, Cain was a tiller of the ground.*

Genesis 4:3 – *And it came to pass at the end of the growing season that brought Cain of the fruit of the ground an offering to Yahweh.*

Genesis 4:4 – *And Abel he also brought [his offering] the firstborn of his flock and of their fat.*

to exist – ‘to be, also the root word for God’
- [1] **mib-be-ko-ROT**
of the firstborn – ‘the first of the birth line, and carrying a conferred status’
- [54] **min-KHAH**
an offering – ‘a gift, a tribute or a sacrificial offering’
- [23] **miq-KETZ**
in the course of – ‘at the end of something, the conclusion, or having reached an extremity’
- [1] **sha-AH**
and looked unfavorably Yahweh – ‘to gaze at without respect, to not have regard for or to not look upon with favor’
- [269] **ya-MIM**
knew – ‘to have intimate familiarity’
- [64] **yaw-DAW**
of time – ‘a division of time’
- [1] **yu-me-kheh-ve-HEN**
and of their fat – ‘the best, the richest or the choicest part’
- [28] **wat-tah-HAR**
and she conceived – ‘to become pregnant’

and bore – ‘to bring forth, as in giving birth of a child’
