**Genesis 4:7** – *If you do well, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it.*

**Genesis 4:8** – *And talked Cain with Abel, his brother, and it came to pass, when they were in the field, Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and killed him.*

**Genesis 4:9** – *And said Yahweh to Cain, "Where is your brother, Abel?" And Cain said, "I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?"*

- [61] ***bah-sah-DEH***  
*in the field* – ‘a place unfrequented, for the purpose of being exposed to violence’
- [4] ***bih-YOW-tam***  
*when they were* – ‘infers a locality, to be in a certain place’
- [1] ***hah-so-MER***  
*keeper* – ‘a bodyguard, to be one’s protector, or to guard thoroughly’
- [2] ***nah***  
*A fugitive* – ‘a person who flees trying to escape danger (such as persecution)’
- [24] ***nood***  
*a wanderer* – ‘to be disturbed, agitated or to tremble in fear’
- [39] ***NOO-ah***  
*a mental state* – ‘to shake, to waver, to move to and fro’
- [2] ***so-ah-QIM***  
*and killed him* – ‘to slay, or kill having deadly intent’
- [2] ***wah-NAD***  
*a wanderer* – ‘a vagrant’
- [3] ***way-vah-hah-REG-hu***  
*cries out* – ‘to shriek, to shout, or to summon’
- [100] ***way-yah-QAM***  
*rose up* – ‘to arise, in a hostile sense, out of an ambush scenario’

*and talked* – ‘to say, to speak or to utter words’  
– ‘argued, challenged or threatened’
