

## [ A Key Verses 8 ]

**Genesis 4:11** – *Now you are cursed from the ground, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood from your hand.*

**Genesis 4:13** – *And Cain said to Yahweh, "My iniquity is greater than can be forgiven!"*

**Genesis 4:14** – *Behold, You have driven me out today, from the face of the ground and from Your face I shall be hidden, and I shall be a fugitive and a vagrant on the earth, and it will come to pass, that anyone who finds me will kill me.*

**Genesis 4:15** – *And said Yahweh to him, "Therefore whoever kills Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold." And Yahweh set a mark on Cain, lest anyone finding him should kill him.*

**Mark 3:28** – *Truly, I say to you that all will be forgiven the sons of the men, the sins and the blasphemies, as many as they shall have blasphemed.*

**Mark 3:29** – *However, whoever shall blaspheme against the Holy Spirit, has no forgiveness in the everlasting, rather they are guilty of eternal sin.*

**Matthew 12:31** – *Because of this I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven of men, however against the Holy Spirit blasphemy will not be forgiven.*

**Matthew 12:32** – *And if whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him, whoever now speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, neither in this age or in the coming one.*

## [ B Definitions 5 ]

**blasphemy of the Holy Spirit** – *'Knowingly and intentionally rejecting the Word of God'*

**detestable** – *'arousing or meriting intense dislike'*

**iniquity** – *'gross injustice'*

**injustice** – *'the intentional and deliberate violation of the rights of another'*

**scurrilous** – *'vulgar and evil'*

[ C Greek Words 2 ]

- [3] **blas-phem-MEE-eye**  
the blasphemies – ‘abusive or scurrilous language’
- [1] **ham-MAR-theh-mat-tah**  
the sins – ‘the consequences of making any decision (leading to action) by self, rather than of faith (God invoked persuasion)’

[ D Hebrew Words 6 ]

- [31] **ah-RUR**  
curse – ‘to be declared as being evil and/or detestable to the LORD’
- [7] **ah-VONE-nee**  
iniquity – ‘iniquity, guilt or sin’
- [1] **naw-SAW**  
than I can bear – ‘to lift, to bear or to forgive’
- [1] **min-neh-SO**  
than I can bear – ‘rising up, rebelling or participating in an insurrection’
- [17] **o-wt**  
mark – ‘a sign, a token or a mark’
- [1] **yah-har-GEN-nee**  
will kill me – ‘to put to death, or to strike with deadly intent’
