ark – *'something that affords protection and safety'*

bequeath – *'to convey something to someone as a privilege or favor without cost or price'*

eschatological – *'relating to the events approaching the end of the world'*

mid-tribber – *'those who believe the rapture will occur at the midpoint of the Tribulation'*

parable – *'usually a short fictitious story illustrating a moral attitude or religious principle'*

post-tribber – *'those who believe the rapture will occur near the end of the Tribulation'*

pre-tribber – *'those who believe the rapture will occur before the start of the Tribulation'*

rapture – *'the bodily removal of all true, fully fledged followers of Jesus Christ from the earth up to heaven'*

volition – *'the power of choosing or determining one's own way'*

- [77] ***bah-sil-LEE-ah***
kingdom – ‘the literal and figurative kingdom, referring especially to the rule of Christ in believers’ hearts’
- [27] ***DEH-kah***
ten – ‘the numerical value of ten’
- [7] ***el-lah-BO-men***
have received – ‘to take, to receive, or to lay hold of’
- [23] ***ex-EL-thon***
went forth – ‘to proceed out, to depart, to elude or escape’
- [1] ***EYE-doe-men***
we may know – ‘to perceive, to know or to be made aware of’
- [1] ***har-PAD-zo***
rapture – ‘to be seized, to be snatched or to be taken by force’
- [1] ***har-PAG-ges-SO-meh-tha***
will be caught away – ‘to be seized, to be snatched or to be taken by force’
