**John 20:8** – *So the other disciple who had first come to the tomb then also entered, and he saw and believed.*

**Matthew 28:16** – *But the eleven disciples proceeded to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated.*

**Matthew 28:17** – *When they saw Him, they worshipped Him; but some were doubtful.*

**Matthew 28:18** – *And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth."*

**Matthew 28:19** – *"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."*

**doubt** – *'to call into question the truth of something.'*

**immersion learning** – *'instruction based on extensive exposure to surroundings or conditions that are native and pertinent to the object of study.'*

**jurisdiction** – *'the power, right or authority to interpret and apply the law.'*

baptized – ‘to immerse, but specifically of ceremonial dipping’

however – ‘but, and, now, moreover or yet’
- [1] **ed-dis-TAD-san**  
doubted – ‘to waver, have misgivings or to hesitate’
- [14] **ep-pis-TOY-sen**  
believed – ‘to have a level of human inspired belief or confidence’
- [29] **ex-oo-ZEE-ah**  
authority – ‘to have power, right, force and jurisdiction’
- [33] **hoi**  
some – ‘who, which, what or that’

name – ‘a person’s character, fame or reputation’
