

[**A** Key Verses **4**]

Matthew 24:3 – *“As was sitting He upon the Mount of Olives, came to Him the disciples in private, saying, “Tell us, when these things will be? And what is the sign of Your coming and of the consummation of the age?”*

Matthew 24:4 – *And answering—Jesus said to them, “Take heed lest anyone mislead you.”*

Matthew 24:5 – *“For many will come in My name, saying, that I am the Christ, and they will mislead many.”*

Matthew 24:32 – *“Now, learn the parable from the fig tree: when already the branch is made to be tender and it puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.”*

imminent – *‘ready to take place, as in happening soon’*

imminent – *‘often used of something bad or dangerous see as being menacingly near’*

seduced – *‘to persuade someone to the point of disobedience or disloyalty’*

- [33] **BLEP-peh-tay**
take heed – ‘to beware, to observe or to examine something carefully’
- [10] **el-eh-OOH-son-tie**
will come – ‘to appear, to arrive or to enter’
will come – ‘to come before the public, as in making one’s appearance’
- [3] **plan-NES-say**
mislead – ‘to be led astray, to be deceived or to be seduced’
- [3] **plan-NES-soo-sin**
mislead – ‘to lead astray, to be deceive or to cause to wander’
