Acts 17:2 – *And according to Paul's custom, he visited them, and for three Sabbath's reasoned with them from the Scriptures,*

tumult – *'disorderly agitation of a crowd, resulting in an uproar and confusion'*

woe – *'to express grief, regret or distress'*

commotion – ‘disorder, confusion and tumult’

rumors – ‘infamy, speculations or hearsay’

to hear of – ‘to come to the ears, to be reported or to give audience to’
- [4] **die-el-lah-GET-toe**
reasoning – ‘speaking to a conclusion or attempting to get across logical analysis’

you will begin – ‘to be at or near to the point of experiencing or suffering something’
