

[**A** Key Verses **5**]

Matthew 24:6 – *“You will begin then to hear of wars and rumors of wars. Behold, but be not alarmed for it is necessary for this to take place, but not yet is the end.”*

Matthew 24:14 – *“And there will be proclaimed this gospel of the kingdom in all the earth for a testimony to all the nations; and then will come the end.”*

Matthew 24:21 – *“For then there will be a great tribulation, such as had not occurred since the beginning of the world, nor ever will.”*

Matthew 24:22 – *“And if those days had not been shortened, there would not have been saved any flesh, however because of the elect those days will be shortened.”*

[**B** Definitions **3**]

Great Reformation – *‘seven-year period where many people will willingly come to Christ. It will be the time immediately preceding the Tribulation’*

Great Tribulation – *‘seven-year period spoken of in the Bible, which will be the worst time in human history. It will culminate with the return of Jesus Christ’*

Swallow – *‘absorbing doctrine as in accepting it without question, protest or resentment’*
