**2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 2:5** – *“If He did not spare the ancient world when He brought the flood on its ungodly people, but protected Noah, a preacher of righteousness, and seven others.”*

**blameless** – *‘pertains to the physical realm’*

**God’s grace** – *‘unmerited favor, no way earned or warranted in any way’*

**just** – *‘acting or being in conformity with what is morally right or good’*

**perversion** – *‘to alter from the original correct form over to a lesser or depraved one’*

**physical brutality** – *‘behavior characteristic of those who demonstrate a lack of intelligence, sensitivity or compassion for others in their actions’*

**preacher** – *‘a herald of divine truth’*

**social oppression** – *‘to promote harmony and unity via the spread of information’*

**unjust gain** – *‘work to obtain resources or acquire economic advantage via fraudulent means’*

DNA – ‘genealogically pure having no angelic blood’
