Mark 13:1 – *“And as he was going out of the temple complex, one of His disciples said to Him, Teacher, look! What massive stones! What inspiring buildings!”*

point out – ‘to show, to designate or to exhibit’

[6] **ep-por-YOU-eh-toe**

He was walking away – ‘to traverse, to travel or to remove oneself from a place’

[21] **ex-EL-thon**

having gone forth – ‘to depart, to escape or to get away from’

[19] **high-er-ROO**

temple – ‘a sacred place, denotes entire Temple Mount’

[3] **kat-tah-LIE-theh-see-tie**

will be thrown down – ‘to tear down, to demolish, or to disintergrate’

[1] **po-tah-PIE**

impressive – ‘wonderful or magnificent’

[1] **po-tah-POI**

massive – ‘what manner of?!’

[2] **oy-ko-do-MAS**

buildings – ‘in the sense of their structure and architecture. Suitable as a place where the LORD would feel “at home” inside’

came to – ‘to approach, to come to, or to draw near’
