

[**A** Key Verses **6**]

Genesis 5:24 – *Enoch walked with God; then he was not there because God took him.*

James 1:17 – *Every generous act and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of Lights; with Him there is no variation or shadow cast by turning.*

Malachi 4:5 – *Look, I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before the great and dreadful Day of the LORD comes.*

Revelation 1:20 – *The secret of the seven stars you saw in My right hand and of the seven gold lampstands is this: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.*

Revelation 11:3 – *I will empower My witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.*

Revelation 11:4 – *These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the LORD of the earth.*

[**B** Definitions **3**]

Elijah – *'an Old Testament prophet who was a Hebrew and lived in the 9th century BC'*

Enoch – *'the 7th patriarch down in the lineage from Adam'*

martyr – *'those who voluntarily suffer death as the penalty for declaring their belief in and refusal to diminish the Word of the LORD in any manner'*

[**C** Greek Words **7**]

- [23] **DOE-sow**
grant authority – ‘to bestow, to deliver or to bequeath’
- [1] **eh-lah-EE-ah**
olive trees – ‘an olive (either the tree or the fruit of the tree)’
- [2] **lych-NEE-ah**
lamp stands – ‘candlesticks or a lamp stand’
- [3] **MAR-tie-sin**
witnesses – ‘a witness in the judicial sense, or a martyr’
- [2] **per-re-beh-BLE-men-oy**
clothed – ‘to throw all around, to cast about, to array, or to display’
- [3] **prof-fet-TWO-so-sin**
prophesying – ‘to speak under divine inspiration’
- [1] **SAK-kos**
sackcloth – ‘a very coarse cloth, traditionally woven from black goat’s hair’

[**D** Hebrew Words **5**]

- [5] **eh-lee-YAH**
Elijah – ‘Yahweh is God’
- [106] **hag-gah-DOHL**
great – ‘exceedingly great, inordinate in importance, magnitude and extent’
- [13] **hah-NO-wk**
Enoch – ‘to narrow, in the sense of bringing discipline or to initiate and train up, so as to make one dedicated’
- [5] **way-yit-hal-LEK**
then he was not there – ‘to walk in the ways of God’
- [10] **weh-han-NOWR-rah**
dreadful – ‘to be made afraid, to be put into fearful reverence by a terrible act’
