

[A Key Verses 12]

1st Corinthians 2:12 – *Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God.*

1st Corinthians 2:13 – *Which things we also speak, not in the words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words.*

1st Thessalonians 1:10 – *And to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.*

2nd Corinthians 5:15 – *And He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.*

Acts 1:10 – *And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them.*

Acts 1:11 – *They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who had been taken up from you from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."*

John 3:3 – *Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."*

John 18:2 – *Now Judas also, who was betraying Him, knew the place, for Jesus had after because Jesus had often met there with His disciples.*

John 18:3 – *Judas then, having received the Roman cohort and officers from the chief priests and the Pharisees, came there with lanterns and torches and weapons.*

Matthew 26:53 – *"Or do you think that I cannot appeal to My Father, and He will at once put at My disposal more than twelve legions of angels?"*

Matthew 26:56 – *But all this has taken place to fulfill the Scriptures of the prophets. Then all the disciples left Him and fled.*

Romans 6:6 – *Knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;*
