

Audio Sermon Message #7 Are You King of the Jews?

[A Key Verses 10]

2nd Corinthians 5:21 – *He made Him who knew no sin, to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.*

John 18:29 – *Therefore, Pilate went out to them and said, "What accusation do you bring against this Man?"*

John 18:30 – *They answered and said to him, "If this Man were not an evildoer, we would not have delivered Him to you."*

John 18:31 – *So Pilate said to them, "Take Him yourselves, and judge Him according to your law." The Jews said to him, "We are not permitted to put anyone to death."*

John 18:34 – *Jesus answered, "Are you saying this of your own initiative, or did others tell you about Me?"*

John 18:35 – *Pilate answered, "I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests delivered You to me; what have You done?"*

Luke 23:2 – *And they began to accuse Him, saying, "We found this man misleading our nation and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, and saying that He Himself is Christ, a King."*

Luke 23:3 – *So Pilate asked Him, saying, "Are You king of the Jews?" And He answered him and said, "It is as you say."*

Matthew 5:18 – *"For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass from the Law until all is accomplished."*

Matthew 12:30 – *"He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters."*

[B Definitions 2]

impute – *'to credit or ascribe something to a person or cause.'*

insurrection – *'an act or instance of rising in revolt, rebellion, or resistance against civil authority or an established government.'*

- [75] **eh-poi-EE-sen**
made – ‘to manufacture, to construct or to fashion’
- [1] **GEN-oh-meth-tha**
might become – ‘to do or to accomplish something’
- [1] **guh-NON-ta**
knew – ‘to know or to experience relationally or intimately’
- [6] **pah-REL-they**
pass away – ‘to come to an end, to pass out of sight or to be rendered void’
- [6] **par-rah-DOE-kan**
delivered – ‘to hand over something or someone to another, to deliver with a sense of close personal involvement’
- [3] **sin-NAH-gone**
gathers – ‘to gather, to assemble or to collect’
- [3] **skor-PITZ-zei**
scatters – ‘to dissipate, to disperse or to waste’
