**John 15:13** – *“Greater love than this love no one has, that One the life of Him should be laid down for the friends of Him.”*

**John 15:14** – *“You are a friend of mine if you do what I command you.”*

**John 15:15** – *“No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing. You however, I have called My friends, because all things I heard from My Father, I have made known to you.”*

**John 17:23** – *“I am in them, and You are in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that it was You who sent Me, and loved them, even as you love Me.”*

**John 17:25** – *“O, righteous Father, although the world has not known You, yet I know You; and these have known that You sent Me.”*

**John 17:26** – *“And I have made known Your name to them, and will make it known, so that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.”*

**gather** – *‘to indicate the making or assembling of disciples or bringing lost sheep together.’*

**liberty** – *‘the quality or state of being free.’*

**servitude** – *‘a condition in which one lacks liberty, especially to determine one’s course of action or way of life.’*

**slaves** – *‘a person who is in servitude.’*

to make known – ‘to reveal, to inform or to declare’
